





You'll fill in blank spaces with facts you hear, like names and numbers. Make sure to use the **exact words** from the audio and follow any **word limits**.

What is Form Completion in IELTS Listening?

Form completion questions often appear in Section 1 of the IELTS Listening test. The recording will usually be a telephone conversation between two speakers. You'll typically encounter two main types of forms: **application forms** and **order or quotation forms**.

To answer IELTS Listening Form Completion questions, quickly read the form before the audio plays to identify the factual information needed (like names, numbers, addresses). You will get 20 seconds to read and understand the topic. Listen carefully for these specific details, writing down the **exact words** you hear, and always adhere to the given **word limit** to avoid losing marks.

IELTS Listening Form Completion Tips

To ace IELTS Listening Form Completion questions, follow these key steps:

- Read Instructions Carefully: Always start by checking the instructions at the top of the question paper. These tell you the question type and, crucially, the word limit for your answers. Exceeding this limit, even with a correct answer, will result in lost marks.
- Understand the Context: Look for a title before the questions; it helps you understand what the audio is about. If there's no title, get clues about the context from the questions themselves.









- Predict Answers: Before the audio starts, read through the questions and predict the type of information each answer will be (e.g., a surname, date, phone number). This helps you focus on relevant details during the recording. Form completion answers are almost always factual: names, places, numbers, etc.
- Boost Your Vocabulary: A strong vocabulary is essential. You need to quickly understand spoken numbers, prices, dates, times, letters, and addresses. Familiarize yourself with common IELTS Listening vocabulary to be prepared.
- Spot Synonyms and Paraphrasing: The questions might use synonyms or paraphrased sentences instead of the exact words from the audio. Be alert for these rephrased ideas when reviewing the questions.
- **Beware of Distractors:** Listen out for **distracting words** like "but" or "however." These can change the meaning or introduce alternative information, so always think carefully before committing to an answer.
- Follow the Answer Order: The good news is that the answers in the audio will always appear in the **same order** as the questions on your paper. This makes it easier to follow along and find each answer sequentially.
