Answers for the IELTS Listening Sentence Completion Questions - Sample 1

1. Objectives

Audio transcript: First, as with every other task, it's important to be clear about the objectives of your workshop.

2. Participants

Audio transcript: Getting there ahead of the participants puts you at ease, and also gives you time to arrange all necessary tools such as projector, laptop, and even to go through your notes.

3. Building

Audio transcript: It also gives you the chance to interact informally with the participants as they arrive, thus building a rapport for the session.

4. Conventional

Audio transcript: Although it's a conventional method, it has not lost its charm. If you have the time, you can give each participant a chance for self-introduction along with a brief description of what they do.

5. Schedule

Audio transcript: Mention the day's schedule, making sure you stick to it and assure them of useful takeaways throughout the session.

6. Interest

Audio transcript: But participants tend to lose interest in the post-lunch sessions or the second half.

7. Facilities

Audio transcript: Please ensure that the selected venue has functioning facilities such as a clean washroom, air-conditioning or heating as required, fire safety, hygienic restroom facilities, emergency exits, refreshments and lunch or dinner arrangements.

8. Ground rules

Audio transcript: Write these ground rules on the whiteboard or the screen for reference or clarification if and when required.

Answers for the IELTS Listening Sentence Completion Questions - Sample 2

1. Assess



- Read instructions carefully: Always check the word limit (e.g., NO MORE THAN ONE WORD). Answers exceeding the limit will be marked incorrect.
- Use the prep time wisely: Before the audio begins, skim through the instructions, title, and questions to understand the context.
- Underline keywords
- Identify key terms in each sentence to help you locate the correct information during the recording. *Example:*
 - "In the eighteenth century, the 31 still determined..."
 - "In Cheshire, 34 _____ was mined..."

- Stay focused throughout the recording: The audio plays only once. A moment's distraction can make you miss the answer.
- Practice multitasking: You must listen, read, understand, and write all at once. Regular practice will improve this skill.
- Follow the order of questions: Answers appear in the same order as the questions. Finish one and move to the next.
- Predict the missing word: Try to guess the type of word (noun, verb, number, etc.) that fits before the audio begins.
- Watch out for synonyms and paraphrasing: The words in the recording may differ from those in the question. Be ready to recognize rephrased information.
 - E.g.: "made" → "created", "since" → "from"
- Check for grammatical accuracy: Ensure the word you write fits grammatically into the sentence. Incorrect forms will result in lost marks.
- Don't leave blanks—make an educated guess: If unsure, try a logical answer. There's no penalty for wrong answers, so always write something.
- **Listen for corrections or changes:** Speakers may change their statement mid-sentence. Wait for confirmation before writing the answer.
- Use the transfer time wisely: In the paper-based test, you'll get 10 minutes to transfer answers. Use this time to review and double-check your responses.
