







1. The pie chart shows the amount of money that a children's charity located in the USA spent and received in one year.

Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features and make comparisons where relevant.

The given pie chart depicts the revenue sources as well as expenditures of the children's charity in one year.

Overall, in the revenue sources of \$53,561,589, the maximum amount of money came from donated food. And, the charity spent more money on program services which amounted to 95.8% of the total \$53,224,896.

To start with, charity collected a very majority of revenue from Donated food. The second most revenue was covered by community contributions. Both the investment income and government grants got a very small amount of revenue. And, the percent of other income is 0.4%. The total amount of revenue received by the USA children's charity was \$53,561,580.

While in the expenditures section, the maximum percentage was taken by program services. The rest of the two sections, Fundraising and Management and general, accounts for 2.6% and 1.6%. The overall amount of expenditure is \$53,224,896.

The pie chart illustrates how much the children's charity based in the USA earned and spent in a one year period.

As per the pie chart, the total amount spent by charity is about \$53,224,896 and the overall income it got is around \$53,561,580. Donated food is the dominant revenue source to the children's charity, whereas it is spent majorly on different program services.

In the Revenue section, eighty six and six-tenth of percent of money is covered by the Donated food. Community contributions is the second most profitable source of income, which is eight times lesser than the donated food. And, the other sources are gained only a very small percentage including Program Revenue, Investment Income, Government grants and other income.

Childrens' charity largely spent their money on Program services, 95.8%. The remaining 4.2% was splited into two sections, fundraising which is 2.6% and the management and general which is 1.6%.

The pie chart represents the different sections of costs and the income sources of the American charity organization devoted to children.

An overall amount of money the charity gained is \$53,561,589. And, the expenditure amount is \$336693 lesser compared to the revenue amount. There are revenue sources including six sections while expenditures consist of three sections.

According to the pie chart, in the revenue section, the topmost profitable source was donated food, 86.6% and the least earning source was Government grants and Investment income. The percentage of both is 0.2%. And, community contributions contributed 10.4% of money as an income. The remaining 2.6% comes under program revenue and other income.

A large amount of money was spent on different program services which is 95.8%. 2.6% of money spent for raising funds while management and general accounts for 1.6%. It should be noted that charity was able to cover the expenditures with the revenue amount they have got.

The given pie chart shows both the percentage of expenditures and revenue sources of the USA based children charity organization.

Overall, the money that was spent by the charity was less than the amount it earned. The total amount of revenue was \$53,561,589, while the overall dollar amount was \$53,224,896. Charity spent most of the money for program services and it got a lot of revenue from donated food.

On the basis of data given in the pie chart, in revenue sources, it should be noted that 86.6% of money came from donated food. 10.4% of money was gained from community contributions. The revenue from the programs was around 2.2%. The rest 0.8% was covered by Government grants, Investment Income and Other Income.

In the expenditures section, charity was largely spent on program services, which is 95.8%. The remaining two were fundraising and management and general. The percentage of the former is 2.6%, whereas the latter is 1.6%.
